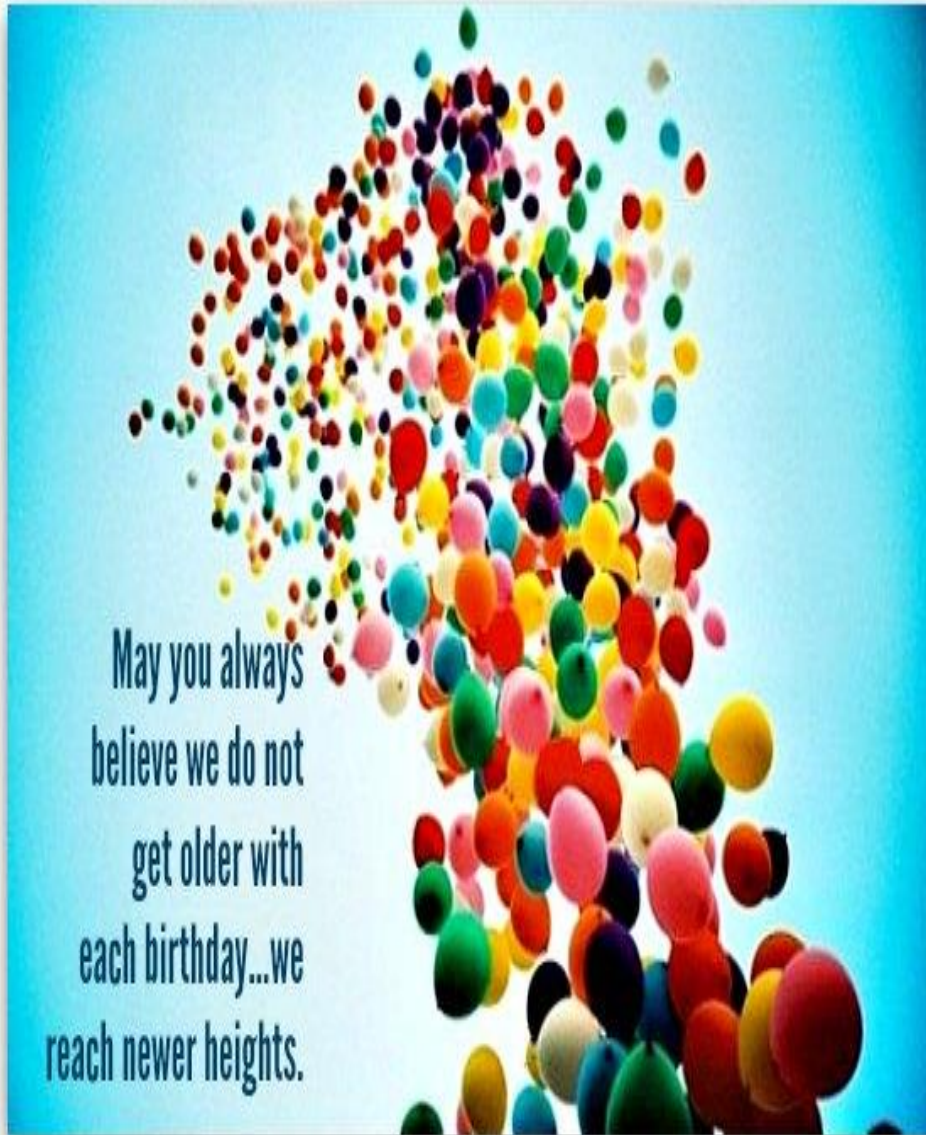

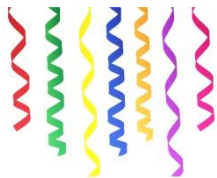

Registration began without a hitch. Old friends gathered in the hallways and hugs and smiles filled the room. Registration packages were given out. Bags included Agendas and other special treats.

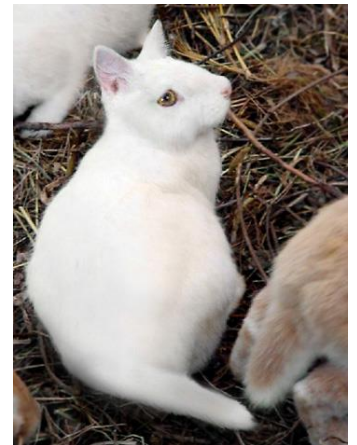
